

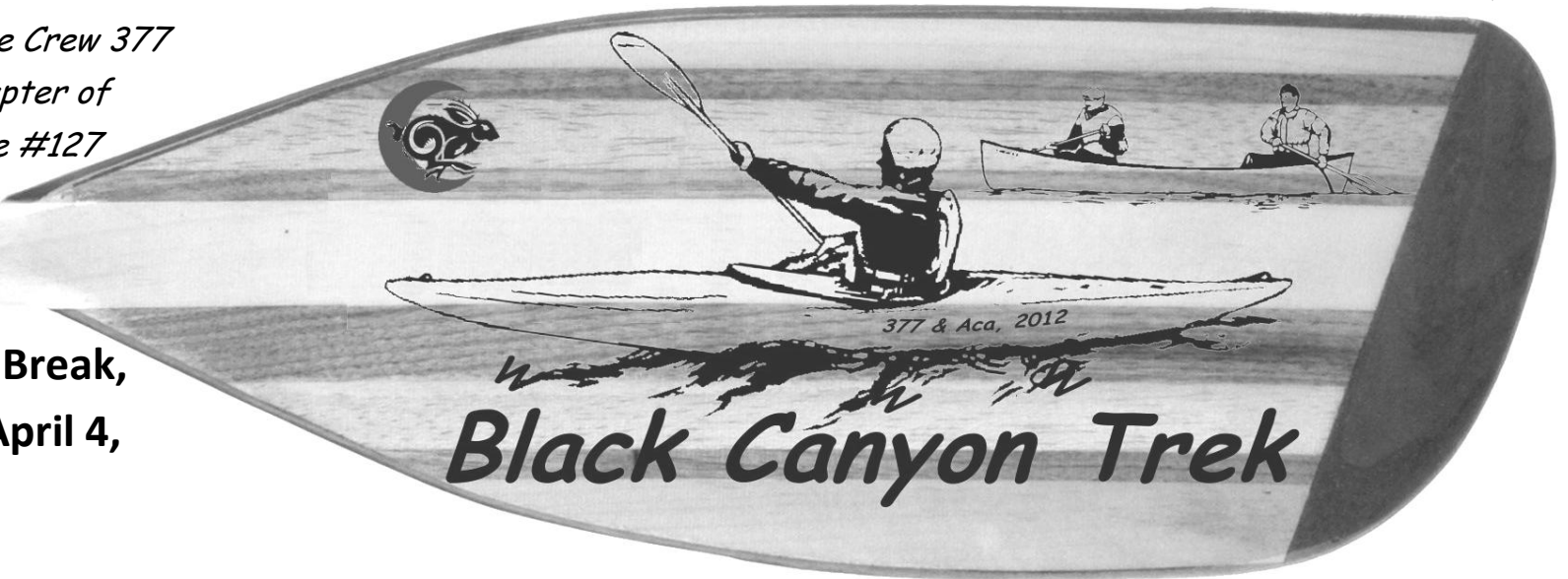

Canoe And Kayak Trip To Explore Black Canyon On The Colorado River

Order of the Arrow members over 14 years of age and venturers are invited to a canoe and kayak trip to explore the Black Canyon on the Colorado River during the spring break of 2012.

We will be launching from Willow Beach and trekking down to Cottonwood Cove. This trek will be through the famous Black Canyon. This area is renowned for its history, sheer rock canyons, and abundant wildlife. We will be spending ample time exploring the many coves and other hidden areas that this area is known for. Scouts will be able to earn their 50 miler patch from this trek.

The price is \$150 per person, limited to 18 people. The price includes food, transportation, boats, PFDs, and paddles. There will be mandatory paddle craft and safety afloat training held on Feb. 28 and a makeup date on March 17 at Lake Perris SRA.
