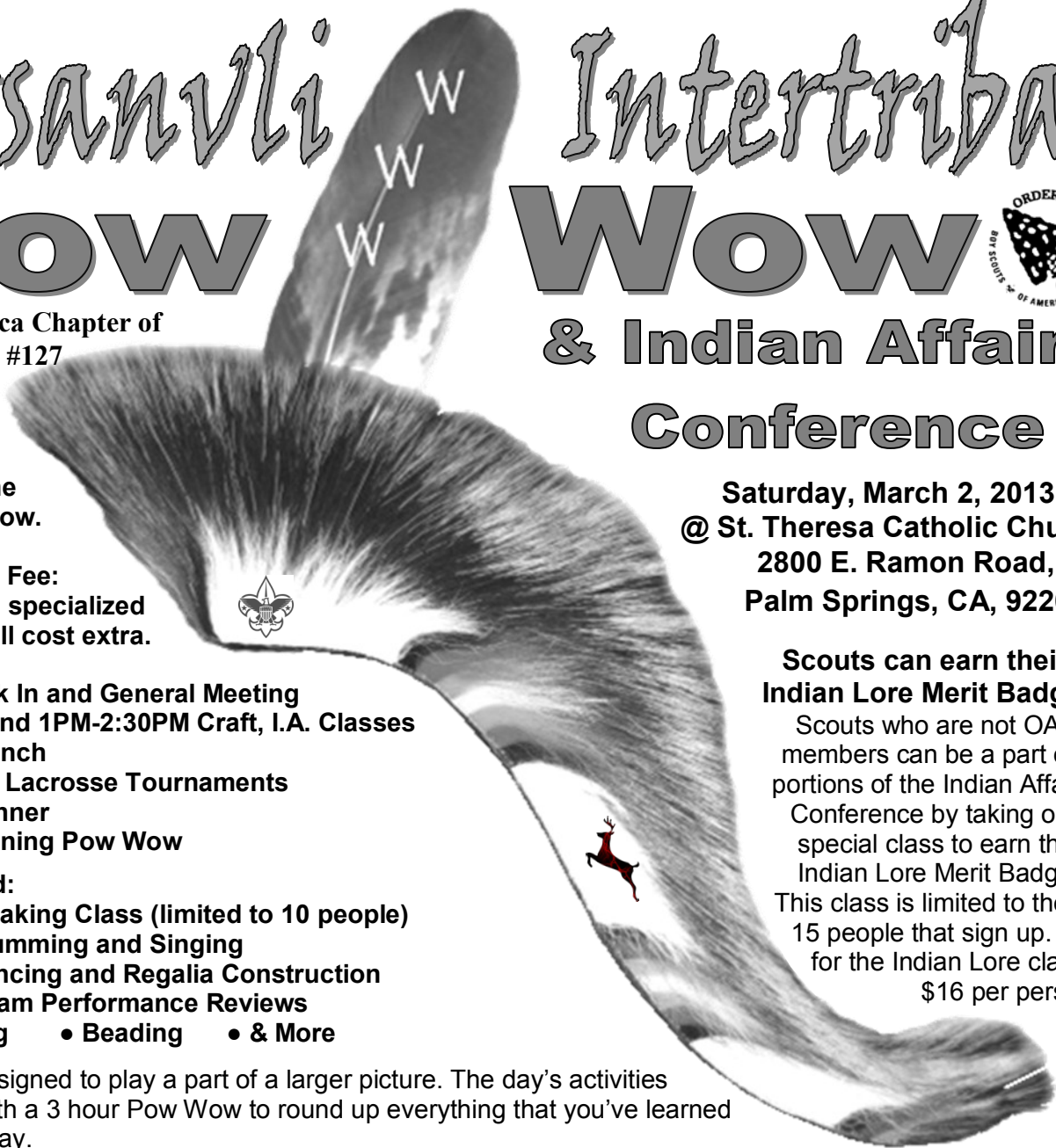

Directions To The Event:

Coming Los Angeles, Riverside, San Diego:
Take the I10 east and turn right (south) on Gene Autry Trail for 4.6 miles.

Turn right (west) on to E. Ramon Rd. for 1.4 miles.

Turn right (north) on S. Compadre Rd. and then turn an immediate left on E. Ramon Frontage Rd. and follow the last drive way on the right.

From Phoenix, Imperial Valley, Indio:

Take the I10 West and turn left (west) on Ramon Rd. for 6.6. miles.

Turn right (north) on S. Compadre Rd. and then turn an immediate left on E. Ramon Frontage Rd. and follow the first drive way on the right.
